Fall Season**

Assigning Instructions for the 2011 Upper Division Season

The following is a general outline of the assigning process for the 2011 Upper Division Season. Individual Assigners may differ from this process and of course, assignments made close to game time require skipping many of these steps. Each field is associated with an Area 1-C Region. Volunteers from those Regions will have preference provided their qualifications meet the game requirements, and they indicate their interest timely to the game date. Every volunteer has been ranked according to Area and Region assessments of their abilities and games they are qualified to center or assist. These rank numbers should correspond to the game difficulty assessment that is established by Area.

Steps

1. Assigners (list below) will send out email requests for interest several weeks in advance.
2. If you are available and interested in working as a referee or assistant, please respond to the Assigner's request as soon as possible. That being said, please continue to indicate interest for upcoming dates and games as your personal schedule becomes known to you.
3. Provided your interest is noted within two days of the Assigner's email, preference will be given to volunteers from the Region providing the field.
4. Assigners will contact nominee Referees and ARs via phone, personal email or Arbiter email.
5. Nominees will generally have three days to accept or decline the assignment.
 - a. If you decline an assignment, you will be "blocked" from other Upper Division games that day. If you have a specific issue with the assignment, you should communicate it to the Assigner.
 - b. If you accept the game, the game will show in your Arbiter schedule and you will receive a reminder email 2 days prior to the game.
6. Approximately 5 days before the game date, games will be placed on "Self Assign". Games on Self-Assign will be visible to volunteers based on the game difficulty rank and your Arbiter rank.
